Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.25 dated 09.03.2014, under Sections 452, 325, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 19.11.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that it is a case of version and cross-version.

Notice of motion for 29.01.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. They shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Sub Inspector Manjit Singh has submitted that the petitioners

have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 19.11.2014, is made absolute.
