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**NAVITA SINGH, J**

There was cross version on either side. FIR No.40 of 13.05.2014 was registered at Police Station Garhshankar. Parties in both the above said petitions, who are complainant on one side and the accused on the other, have arrived at a compromise. Statements of the parties concerned were recorded by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate,

Garhshankar and the Magistrate expressed his opinion that the compromise between the parties was without any pressure or coercion. As per the report from the SHO concerned, no proceedings regarding declaring any of the accused as proclaimed offender were pending nor any other criminal case was pending against any of the parties on either side. In view of this, there should not be any impediment in allowing the parties to compromise the matter. Support to this view can be had from the authority *Kulwinder Singh & ors. Vs. State of Punjab & ors., 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052.*

In view of the above, the petitions are accepted. The above-said FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.
