LISA GILL, J.

The petitioners pray for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 151 dated 06.11.2014 registered under Sections 447, 511, 379, 506 IPC at Julkan, District Patiala.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners and the complainant Bahadur Singh have settled the matter amicably though not before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as had been directed on 20.11.2014. Affidavit dated 5/7.1.2015 of the complainant – Bahadur Singh is filed in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms and verifies the settlement between the parties and fairly states that she has no objection to the grant of anticipatory bail to the said petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmit

Singh, confirms that the petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 20.11.2014 is made absolute qua petitioners -Gagandeep Kaur and Dharamjit Singh.

The present petition is, accordingly, allowed.
