1. The present petition has been filed by petitioner Kuldeep Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of the anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 239 dated 01.10.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

2. During the pendency of the present petition, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement, it being a matrimonial dispute. The matter was settled before the Mediator.

3. As per report of the Mediator, the parties have entered into settlement agreement dated 28.01.2015, which

is available on record. It was one of the condition of the settlement agreement that a sum of Rs, 1,30,000/- shall be paid by the petitioner to the complainant at the time of the final disposal of the present petition.

4. Mr. H.S.Bath, Advocate, learned counsel for the complainant has stated at bar that a sum of Rs. 1,30,000/- has been received by the complainant in cash from the petitioner today itself in the Court.

5. Learned State counsel on the instructions of HC Chana Masih, Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar has stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. Thus, he is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

6. Thus, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 19.11.2014 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure,1973.
