Petitioner is servant of complainant Amarjit Kaur. He had allegedly assaulted and molested her.

Notice was issued to the State. Pursuant to the interim orders, the petitioner has joined investigation.

It was argued on behalf of the petitioner that he had been beaten by the husband of the prosecutrix but in order to create a defence, he has been falsely implicated in the case.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of this case. There are serious allegations against the petitioner that in the capacity as a domestic help, he had entered the room of the prosecutrix and also assaulted here. She was medico legally examined on October 9, 2014 in General Hospital. No doubt, the petitioner has joined investigation but the circumstances of the present case do not permit the grant of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed. It will be open to the petitioner to surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate or the Investigating Officer to seek concession of regular bail.
