Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners by providing police protection and further directions be issued to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners illegally at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 and other relatives. Further directions are sought to respondents or anybody else to not to interfere into the peaceful married life of the petitioners and not to harass the petitioners illegally or forcibly or not to harass them in any manner against their wishes and to their detriment by using force on them or by adopting unlawful means.

On notice, reply has been filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar on behalf of respondents

No.1 to 3 that the present petitioners and Dilbagh Singh father of petitioner No.2, have got recorded their statements to the effect that the petitioners are living happily and safely in their home and now they do not have any threat or danger from anybody and they do not need any protection or security. Statement of respondent No.4-Jasvir Kaur i.e. mother of petitioner No.1 has also been recorded to the effect that she has no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and petitioner No.1 is free to stay wherever she wants to stay with her husband.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.
