1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset learned counsel states that there is an inadvertent error in Annexure P-2(Aadhar Card) insomuch as the date of birth of petitioner No.2 which is 06.01.1995 has not been reflected whereas it is there in the original Aadhar Card. He states that the original Aadhar Card is at present not with petitioner No.2 but he is having his Voter Identity Card wherein his correct date of birth is mentioned and seeks permission to place the same on record. He is allowed to do so.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to

protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.3 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record extract of her Aadhar Card(Annexure P-1)wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 10.04.1995 and petitioner No.2 has placed on record an extract of his Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 06.01.1995. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, District Karnal(Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Superintendent of Police, District Karnal to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
