The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.153 dated 8.6.2012 under Section 498A and 406 IPC registered at Police Station Section 26, Chandigarh along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 7.6.2014.

Heard. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No. 2 has since been amicably settled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that under the settlement, respondent No.2 has been paid a lump-sum amount towards full and final settlement of her entire claim and the parties have also obtained divorce by filing a separate petition under Section 13B of the Hindu

Marriage Act, 1955. Now both the parties are leading their lives amicably and it will be in the interest of parties and their families that above mentioned FIR be quashed.

A report was called from the trial Court about the genuineness and veracity of the alleged compromise between the parties. Report dated 17.12.2014 has been received in this case wherein the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class has informed that the parties have amicably settled the dispute and compromise is genuine and valid.

Respondent No.2 is present and has informed this Court that all her matrimonial disputes are settled and she is satisfied with the same and has no objection if the impugned FIR is quashed.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.153 dated 8.6.2012 under Section 498A and 406 IPC registered at Police Station Section 26, Chandigarh along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
