AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of two applications for anticipatory bail

filed in complaint case No. 03/3.1.2009 titled as Ranvir Singh v. Harjinder Singh alias Biru and others under Sections 120-B, 148, 307, 326, 324, 323, 149 IPC and under Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes(Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 pending in the Court of ACJM, Hoshiarpur. Since the two bail applications have arisen out of a common complaint, they are being disposed of by this common order.

CRM allowed as prayed for. Annexures R-1 to R-4 taken on record.

As regards the anticipatory bail filed by petitioner Saroj Bala is concerned, by order dated 27.11.2014 she had been directed to appear before the trial Court and it is stated that she appeared and was released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant has very vehemently argued that the complainant was injured severely by the henchmen of Saroj Bala and Daljit Singh Khakh and under the pretext of the order granting bail to Daljit Singh Khakh all of them are now seeking anticipatory bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the bail granted to Daljit Singh Khakh was conditional and strict conditions had been imposed by this Court.

The two other petitioners Manjit Singh alias Lucky and Harjinder Singh (petitioners in CRM-M No. 513 of 2015) had allegedly caused severe injuries to the complainant. In the circumstances the bail application of Manjit Singh alias Lucky and Harjinder Singh bearing CRM-M No. 513 of 2015 is dismissed. It is, however, directed that they would appear before the trial Court on the next date fixed and move an application

for regular bail and the same would be decided on merits within two days. In case they appear, the interim bail granted to Saroj Bala shall be confirmed. In default of their appearance this petition would be deemed to be dismissed and the interim bail granted to Saroj Bala shall also be cancelled. In the circumstances CRM-M No. 30626 of 2014 stands disposed of in the above terms.
