Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the judgment passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the matter of *Mohit alias Sonu & another Versus State of U.P. and another, 2013(3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 673*, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition to approach the Court of Session for redressal of his grievances in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the above prayer.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction that if criminal revision petition is presented before the Court of Session within three weeks of passing of this order along with

application for condonation of delay in filing the revision petition, then the said application shall be decided liberally while taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has filed the present petition against the impugned summoning order.
