The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.47, dated 3.6.2014, registered under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station PAU Ludhiana.

The allegations are that two persons were arrested with about 1 kg of heroin and they disclosed to the police that they used to procure the same from their co-accused Sameer Sharma. It is alleged that Sameer Sharma used to travel in the car owned and driven by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that neither the petitioner was arrested from the spot nor was any recovery made from him. He has further argued that though the petitioner has now been in custody for

almost seven months, no evidence has come against him apart from the statement of his co-accused. The aforesaid Sameer Sharma, who is alleged to be the main supplier, has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 06.01.2015, passed in CRM-M No.41246 of 2014, Sameer Sharma vs State of Punjab.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Sukhdeep Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
