AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed in case bearing FIR No. 251 dated 20.07.2014, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.

On 05.12.2014 the following order was passed:-

“ List on 19.2.2015.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation and to appear before the Investigating Officer.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer.

The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2)Cr.P.C.”

Learned Addl.AG, on instruction from the investigating officer, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances the order dated 05.12.2014 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
