By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.39, dated 07.10.2015, registered under Sections 323/324/452/427/380/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 26.11.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the

investigation and recovery has been effected. He further states that petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
