By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.137, dated 10.10.2014, registered under Sections 379, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 37/52A/63 of Copyright Act, 1957, at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel contends that in FIR No. 133 dated 29.05.2014, the entire equipments i.e. Laptop, computer, UPS and CPU, allegedly used by the petitioner were seized by the police. In pursuance of the order dated 18.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
