This order shall dispose of two aforementioned petitions as common facts are involved in both the petitions.

Both petitions under Section 482 Cr.P.C. are for quashing of the order dated 30.10.2010 (**Annexure P-2**), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class (Special Court), Gurgaon, whereby the Criminal Complaint Nos.2624 and

2625 dated 04.03.2010 respectively (**Annexure P-1**) filed under Section 138 read with Section 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 have been dismissed in default for non-prosecution.

Perusal of the previous order reveals that the respondent-company remains unserved due to the premises being sealed. No efforts appeared to have been made for service of the respondent-company.

In view of the above, both the present petitions stand dismissed for want of prosecution.
