AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

The facts of the case are that petitioners No. 1 and 2 are in love with each other for the last four years and went to solemnize marriage but the parents of the girl are opposing the same and pressurizing her to marry the boy of their choice. She tried to convince them but they did not agree. She was even beaten up by her father and grand father. Both the petitioners are stated to be major. In support of

her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record extract of her Middle Examination (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 08.08.1997 and petitioner No.2 has placed on record an extract of his Secondary Examination (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 01.05.1995. Counsel states that the petitioner No.2 is waiting to complete 21 years of age before getting married. Petitioner No.1 has also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa (Annexure P-3) wherein she has mentioned that she is having an affair with petitioner No.2 and wants to marry him but her parents want her to marry the boy of their choice and sought protection of her life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-3).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
