This petition has been filed by petitioner Parma Nand under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter called Cr.P.C) for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 129 dated 08.06.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter called IPC), registered at Police Station Lalru, District S.A.S.Nagar, Mohali.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Didar Singh, Police Station Lalru has stated that the petitioner has again joined the investigation and has been

thoroughly interrogated.

As per the prosecution allegations, the petitioner was present in the office of co-accused Suraj Bhan Jindal where the bargain took place between the complainant and one Vicky. All the material allegations are against the co-accused Suraj Bhan Jindal. Even the earnest money was received by him. The only allegations against the present petitioner was that he was present at the time of deal. He has already joined the investigation thrice and has been separately interrogated. Thus, he is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

Thus, the interim anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.12.2014 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
