The instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 163 dated 6.4.2014 under Sections 279, 427 IPC, Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh and the subsequent proceedings on the basis of written compromise arrived at between the parties.

Report from the trial Court has been received after recording the statements of parties, along with photocopies of statements. It is reported that compromise is voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned U.T. Counsel submits that petitioner is the only accused in the FIR, which was recorded by respondent No. 2 who is the only aggrieved person.

No useful purpose would be served in continuing the proceedings in this case in view of the compromise arrived at between them.
