**RITU BAHRI, J. (Oral)**

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 61 dated 19.03.2012, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir, Panchkula, District Panchkula, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

The FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by Kamaljit son of Som Nath with the allegations that he had gone to Morni Hills for visit in a car bearing registration No.HR-03-N-2700 and a dispute arose with the owner of the resort regarding the payment of the bill and the complainant received injuries.

During the pendency of trial, the matter has now been amicably resolved between the parties.

In compliance with the order dated 20.11.2014, both the

parties got recorded their statements before the trial Court. Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot, has been received in this regard. As per report, complainant in the FIR, made a statement on 19.12.2014 to the effect that the matter has been settled and compromised between the parties and he has no objection, if the FIR is quashed.

In view of statements of the parties, the court is satisfied that the compromise is valid and genuine.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 61 dated 19.03.2012, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir, Panchkula, District Panchkula, Haryana (Annexure P-1) are quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

Disposed of accordingly.
