Petitioner-Surat Mehta has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 423, dated 02.11.2013, for offences under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

The case against the present petitioner/accused alongwith three other co-accused regarding the murder of Montu Mehta is based on circumstantial evidence.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal, states that out of nineteen prosecution witnesses, seventeen witnesses have been examined and the remaining two witnesses have been summoned for 16.12.2015. He, thus, submits that the trial is at fag end.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present bail application.

In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
