RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of direction to official respondents not to call the petitioners to the police station at Kapurthala and Jalandhar on the basis of false complaints made by respondent No.5.

Precise grievance of the petitioners is that despite pendency of civil suit between the parties with regard to an agreement to sell, the petitioners are being summoned in the police station pursuant to a complaint filed by respondent No.5. Earlier also, a similar complaint was filed by respondent No.5 against the petitioners, which was enquired into by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur. Ultimately, the same was not entertained as the matter was civil in nature.

At this stage, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to give a prior notice of 7 days to the petitioners as per the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C, in case they are required in the police station in connection with investigation of a complaint.
