Instant petition has been filed for quashing of complaint No. 55/A/29.05.2010 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure P-3).

2. Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise effected between the parties is without any pressure and coercion and is voluntarily and genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the

observations made in case reported as *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466* I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4.. Consequently, instant petition is allowed and complaint No. 55/A/29.05.2010 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners.
