Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.129 dated 30.8.2015 registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on the asking of Court, read out the statement got recorded by Ms.Kirandeep Kaur and Ms.Ramandeep Kaur on 8.9.2015 before the learned Magistrate under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

A bare perusal of the said statement made by both the prosecutrix makes it clear that petitioner has been given clean chit by the prosecutrix themselves, contending that they went with the petitioner on their own sweet will and no harm was caused to them by or at the instance of the petitioner. Further, petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 26.11.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
