Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439, Cr.P.C., is for grant of bail to the petitioner – Maninder Singh, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code in a case arising out of FIR No.61 dated 10.05.2015, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences punishable under Section 307 IPC has been deleted during the trial and as such the petitioner is facing trial only for

the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel further contends that all the offences for which the petitioner has been booked are triable by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class; the petitioner is behind the bars from 01.07.2015 i.e. approximately 5 months and after completion of the investigation, chargesheet (challan) has been presented and as such, his further incarceration is of no consequence.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from HC Sudesh Kumar of Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar has not controverted the facts narrated by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner – Maninder Singh S/o Shri Shamsher Singh, resident of Ward No.14, Sarmala Road, Morinda, Tehsil Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
