Petitioner has got civil dispute with his brother Manmohan Singh regarding which a civil suit appears to be pending.

Petitioner apprehends harassment at the hands of his brother.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner seeks the relief only to the extent that in case he is required on the complaint of his brother for any inquiry, he should be issued a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

I have considered the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the compliant submitted by the petitioner to DIG, Ferozepur Range, annexure P-2.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.H.K. Athwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Copy given.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to SSP, Ferozepur that the allegations in annexure P-2 would be looked into and in case there is apprehension of any breach of peace on account of mischief of any of the brothers, necessary action for maintaining peace would be taken. However, in case the allegations are found to be false and baseless, it will be open to the concerned inquiring officer to drop the complaint. It will be appreciated in case the matter is looked into within a period of three months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order.
