By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84, dated 29.07.2014, registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341, 427, 148 r/w Section 149 IPC, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel contends that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. The sister of the petitioner has solemnized the marriage with the complainant-Jagtar Singh. In pursuance of the order dated 09.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. The factum of compromise and marriage is duly acknowledged by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
