KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is second anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 130, dated 9.6.2014, registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar. The earlier one, i.e. CRM No. M-24683 of 2014, was dismissed by this Court on 13.1.2015.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that all the contentions sought to be raised now could have been raised at the time of decision of earlier anticipatory bail

petition. It also comes out that despite the elapse of 10 months, the petitioner has not been arrested by the police, which shows that the police is either not able to arrest the petitioner he being a fugitive or the police is doing a favour to the petitioner.

In view of the above, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out. Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail petition is dismissed.
