Petitioner Charanjit Kaur alias Bholi has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.215 dated 12.08.2014, registered at Police Station City Barnala, Tehsil and District Barnala, under Sections 420, 406 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested this bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any further investigation or interrogation purposes. Her presence is required only to face the trial. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 21.11.2014, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
