AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed for quashing of the impugned orders dated 03.09.2015 & 31.10.2015 thereby the application filed by the petitioner under Section 311 Cr.P.C. has been dismissed on two grounds. Firstly, that the petitioner had already taken more than 15 opportunities and secondly two witnesses whom he wanted to examine was well within his knowledge.

Learned counsel has argued that one more opportunity may have been granted subject to payment of costs.

Keeping in view this request, I allow this petition and direct the trial Court to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to examine the bank officials at his own responsibility subject to payment of costs of

Rs.15,000/- to be paid to the respondent.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal
Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
