AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.120 dated 10.05.2015 registered under Sections 307/427/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the allegations some persons had fired shots at the complainant which has resulted in three injuries. He has further argued that the main accused was released on anticipatory bail because the complainant gave an affidavit that he was not present at the spot and the similar affidavit has been given in this

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from the Investigating Officer has accepted this fact but states that in the supplementary statement the complainant has named him.

Be that as it may, since the main accused was granted anticipatory bail on the basis of exculpated affidavit filed by the complainant, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner.

Consequently the petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
