This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. For quashing of FIR No.05 dated 6.2.2013 (Annexure P1) registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 20.10.2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Ludhiana received. The statements of the respondent injured as well as the petitioner have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have entered into compromise and the same is genuine without any threat, coercion, undue influence and with their own sweet will. Since the parties have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No.05 dated 6.2.2013 (Annexure P1) registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34

IPC at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
