By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.112, dated 23.09.2015, registered under Sections 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 27.11.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
