The application has been moved today for amendment of the headnote and prayer clause of the petition, which is taken on record.

Amendment in the headnote and prayer clause is sought as the offence under Section 333 of the Indian Penal Code was added later on.

The application is allowed, as prayed for.

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State counsel has submitted, on instructions from ASI Bakshish Singh of Police Station Kum Kalan, District Ludhiana, that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The petitioner was not named in the FIR (Annexure P1). This case is similar to the case of Sikander Baksh, who was not named in the FIR

and was granted pre-arrest bail on 29.01.2015 by another Bench.

Since the petitioner is not required for any interrogation, the interim bail granted to him is made absolute.

The petitioner shall, however, join investigation as and when required by the police.
