JASPAL SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Sarabjit Singh @ Saba-petitioner, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No. 290, dated 29.10.2013, under Sections 29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'Act'), Section 7/13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Baljinder Singh, has submitted that in compliance of order dated February 04, 2015, passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and is also no more required

for further interrogation.

3. Accordingly, order dated February 04, 2015 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions prescribed under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.:-

- “(i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*
