The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.87 dated 01.09.2015, registered under Sections 494, 406, 420, 380 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') and Sections 497, 498, 506, 120-B IPC added subsequently, registered at Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner is the step-son the complainant and son of the main accused, Jeewan Kumari @ Daljit Kaur. The complainant and co-accused, Jeewan Kumari are residing in the same house. The petitioner has joined the investigation

is pursuance of the orders passed by this Court.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but the recovery is yet to be effected.

Heard.

The petitioner is the step-son of the complainant. The main dispute appears to be between the complainant-husband and his wife. The petitioner has already joined the investigation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
