The petitioners seek quashing of an FIR, which was registered at the instance of Garish Kamboj alleging that the petitioners had forged a civil Court decree by altering the original decree passed by Sub Judge, Jalandhar relating to joint family property between the relations.

It is stated that the matter has been compromised.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case.

Since the forgery has been committed in context to a document of the Court with an objective to play a fraud with the Court also.

No ground is made out for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.
