The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for quashing of the FIR No. 84 dated 25.9.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

In pursuant to the order dated 21.11.2014 passed by this Court, report of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot, received. He has reported that the statement of complainant as well as accused has been recorded. He further reported that parties have voluntarily entered into a compromise and

that the same is of their free will and without any pressure.

A perusal of FIR shows that it was a matrimonial dispute between the parties. Since, the matter has been settled amicably, therefore, the FIR in question alongwith consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
