Reply filed on behalf of respondent No.2 is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition may be disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial against the petitioner within a particular time frame. Proceedings against the petitioner were being taken up for declaring her proclaimed offender while the other accused are already proclaimed offenders.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused are residing outside India and if their presence is awaited, she will suffer the agony of trial without any fault on her part.

Petition is, therefore, disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the case against the petitioner within six months from the date on which the petitioner appears before the trial Court as per direction of this Court.
