Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Suresh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Jind on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, along with statements of the petitioners, namely, Poonam Devi and Deepak Kumar, which are taken on record.

As per the statements of the petitioners namely, Poonam Devi and Deepak Kumar, they are not apprehending any danger and, therefore, they don't want any action in the present case.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition. Consequently, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case the petitioners feel any apprehension and need any protection, they are at liberty to approach concerned Superintendent of Police, who shall consider and extend the protection, as warranted by law.
