Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Pursuant to the order passed by this Court dated 24.11.2015, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that an amount of Rs.1,02,500/- has been deposited in the name of petitioner No.1 in the shape of FDR.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vilasha Ram submits that parents of petitioner No.1 have made statements before the

police that they would not interfere in the matter. Statements made by parents of petitioner No.1 are taken on record.

In view of the statements made by parents of petitioner No.1, no further order is required to be passed by this Court. However, the petitioners are at liberty to approach the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, to seek protection in the event they get such threat from the private respondents.
