The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 as they entered into matrimony against their wishes.

Learned State counsel has filed photocopies of statements of petitioners No. 1 and 2 (Pushpa Soni and Anup Soni) as well as respondent No. 4(Bhagwati Prasad Soni) which are taken on record. A perusal of the statements made by petitioners No. 1 and 2 shows that there is no threat perception to the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned for the

necessary relief in accordance with law.
