RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)

Petitioner by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate action against private respondents so as to ensure that petitioner is not harassed unwarrantedly.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto FIR has been registered against respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in view of the fact that FIR has already been registered, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that because of wholly unwarranted harassment caused by the private respondents, petitioner has committed suicide during the pendency of the present petition.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and after going through the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that once the FIR

has been registered, the private respondents shall face the criminal action in accordance with law. No further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
