AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from private respondents.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner has also filed a representation (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab-respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereon and that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the said respondent to decide the said representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab to look into the matter/ representation(Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and take whatever action he deems necessary.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
