Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 7.

In compliance of the order dated 24.11.2015 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a photocopy FDR for an amount of Rs.5 lacs, in the name of petitioner No.1-Gurpreet Kaur. The photocopy of the said FDR is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No. 4, 5 and 7 submits that there is no threat to the petitioners as alleged in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners being major have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However,

respondents No.4 to 7 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) to Superintendent of Police, Karnal i.e. respondent No.2.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 to take appropriate action, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.
