Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made in the petition, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the allegations as contained in representation dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-2), analyze threat perceptions and to take necessary action as warranted by law.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
