By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.56, dated 10.11.2014, registered under Sections 452, 354, 323 and 509 IPC, at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, Bathinda.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner is the complainant in case FIR No.23 dated 26.04.2013, registered against the husband of the complainant and husband of Meenu Rani, who allegedly appeared on the spot. The other family members, including the children of the complainant, were also present at the time of the

alleged incident.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.11.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
