The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.139, dated 8.10.2015, registered under Sections 420, 376 of the IPC, at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana.

Allegations against the petitioner are two fold. Firstly, he developed physical relations with the prosecutrix on the pretext of marriage and secondly he represented himself to be a Brahmin while he is actually a Muslim.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that even as per the FIR, the prosecutrix had come to know about the real state of affairs and still

continued her relationship with the petitioner. The petitioner has now been in custody since 10.10.2015.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab is not in a position to deny the factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
