The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.91 dated 05.09.2014, under Sections 302, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner/accused is the wife of deceased-Jaspreet Singh for whose death by electric shock, she has been accused of murder by his Devar/complainant-Beant Singh.

It is contended that the deceased husband had suffered a electric shock in the house and died. Since there was no cause for suspicion, the family of the deceased conducted the cremation, however, with ulterior motives after a delay of 20 days, the aforesaid FIR with false allegations was lodged. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2014 and has a 2 ½ year old child to look after.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh, concedes that the material witnesses have since been examined.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the totality of the circumstances and the custody period, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such she is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
