Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.192 dated 20.07.2013, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Section 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Following order was passed by this Court on 30.12.2013:-

"This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 20.07.2013 under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Phillaur, district Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend

that the name of the petitioner does not even figure in the FIR. It is further submitted that the only property purchased by the petitioner from the complainant is about 3 marlas of land and that too, after paying a total sale consideration of Rs.2 lacs vide registered sale deed No.2433 dated 24.02.2011. It is further contended that the sale deed in favour of the petitioner was executed by Karam Singh i.e. the complainant himself.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall remain bound by the conditions enumerated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Sukhwinder Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 30.12.2013, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
