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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Reply on behalf of respondent-State filed in Court, which is taken on record.

It comes out that the Registration Certificate of tractor No. PB-31-G-5124 was taken into possession during the investigation of FIR No. 188 dated 16.8.2009 registered under Sections 148, 324, 326 IPC read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Bhuna. After the trial, the present petitioner was acquitted of the charges framed against him, vide judgment dated 21.12.2013 (Annexure-P-2), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad. The appeal by one of the co-accused is stated to be

pending. However, the Registration Certificate of the said tractor has not been returned. The said tractor is already on *superdari* with the petitioner.

In these circumstances, it is ordered that the original Registration Certificate of the said tractor shall be returned to the petitioner after obtaining photocopy thereof.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
